**SEPAC-** Becca and Maddie will attend the August 26<sup>th</sup> SEPAC Field Day and set up a table to promote the Vernon Fork Watershed Cost-Share Program and Clean Water Indiana Cost-Share Program. Maddie will call Joel Wahlman and find out how to be a sponsor for this event.

**CWI Update-** We have received more applications this month, and we have reached our goal of two HUAPs. We have not had any participants complete their practices and turn in receipts for reimbursement yet, but we should start seeing that in September/October. Continue to share information about this program.

**Watershed Update-** Andy Ertel and Heather Wirth are working hard to complete the second grant. We are waiting for a few more letters of support and Andy or Heather will submit the grant application before the deadline. A rough draft was passed around for review.

Photo Frames- Photo Frame samples were passed around to see if these frames will be better for the picture gallery in the conservation building. The pricing is as follows: 8"X10" (\$30.99/frame) 48 qty. for \$1,456.53. 8.5"X11" (\$23.99/frame) 9 qty. for \$215.91. 13"X19" (\$32.99/frame) 48 qty. for \$1,583.52. Shipping costs \$244.20. Total \$3,500.16. Alex Helms made a motion to purchase photo frames with, a second from Kevin Morin. All were in favor. Becca also received pricing on name plates for the two

hornets' nets, updated snake boxes, and mural they would be around \$10.00 each. Matt Branham made a motion to purchase name plates with a second by Alex Helms. All in favor.

Annual Meeting- Brad is up for reelection, the board will be appointing Brad for Supervisor. Several ideas were discussed and the idea of a "Conservation Expo" was well received. Potential dates are February 21st, February 28th, or March 7th. We will revisit this topic at the September Board Meeting.
