- Letter to Landowner Andy advised the board that we had sent a letter to a landowner who was awarded \$1050 to implement pollinators in with his CRP. He elected not to add the pollinators therefore we requested that he return the funds to the district. After discussion with the DSS it was decided that if the district can fund some landowners within the same scope as the original grant they should do so. Matt Branham made a motion to give the staff the authority to fund landowners that stays within the scope of the original grant with a second from Tom Schneider.

Andy was asked by the council if he could help facilitate some plans for the new park. The board gave their blessing and stated that Andy do only what he feels he has time to assist them with.
